## 9. Las Carolinas. Parque Lineal.



The Benimàmet Parque Lineal is a green area inaugurated in 2018 which is the result of the underground burying of the tram tracks as they passed through the town centre in 2011. The new metrovalencia stations are integrated, and the old las Carolinas train station, which has been restored, is used as a cafeteria. It is decorated with a mural by Alexis Rafael Guevara that recalls the tramway's passage through the station before it was buried underground.

The Parque Lineal comprises a 1200-metre linear promenade that runs from west to east. It has a landscaped area of more than $30,000 \mathrm{~m}^{2}$, a cycle lane, a children's play area, a petanque court, a picnic area, an amphitheatre, a dog socialisation area and several petanque courts.

On the route from Las Carolinas there are various murals by local residents such as Miguel Ángel López Monserrat (design) and painters, J. L. Pérez Ballester, V. Calaforra Lara and M. Folgado Martínez or artists-painters-urban residents of Benimàmet José David Moya Saiz -AYOM32- and Jesús Moya Saiz, with themes related to the town.

The Parque Lineal, by las Carolinas, observes the recovery of three cave dwellings.

## Cafeteria Las Carolinas

## General information

Opening hours: Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 16.30 to 23.30, Thursdays to Saturdays from 08.00 to 00.00 and Sundays from 08.00 to 21.00 .

The Parque Lineal las Carolinas has a cafeteria with an accessible route. It is located in a flat area in the same park with homogeneous paving.

Access to las Carolinas cafeteria is via ramps with a $5.7 \%$ slope, 700 cm long and 270 cm wide.

## Terrace

The Terrace of the Cafetería las Carolinas is located in a flat area, with more than 100 cm of separation between tables.

Toilets
There is an adapted cabin in the gents' toilet with an accessible route. There is signage on door with an approved symbol. Non-slip flooring.

There is an access door to the toilet area which can be opened with a key: request it at the Cafeteria Las Carolinas.

It has a handle-operated door that opens outwards at 116 cm with a clear passage width of 90 cm . There is no return spring. There is a sliding cabin door with a clear passage width of 88 cm . The bolt allows it to be opened from the outside. A circle with a diameter of 150 cm can be traced inside the cabin.

There is an 85 cm washbasin, with 70 cm of clearance underneath and a depth of 45 cm at the bottom. There is a single-lever tap. Non-tilted mirror with lower edge 145 cm from the ground.

There is a toilet access space of 100 cm on the left side, 80 cm on the right side and 150 cm frontal access.

There is an in-cabin alarm system. There are folding support bars on each side at a height of $60-75 \mathrm{~cm}$. The spacing between bars is 65 cm .

## Access

Access to the Cafeteria Las Carolinas is via ramps with slopes between $2.7 \%$ and $5.7 \%$, both of which are over 700 cm long and over 270 cm wide. There are handrails on one ramp on the right at a height of 110 cm and on another on both sides. the start and end of the ramp have no signage. Non-slip paving.

## Toilets

Ladies' toilets are marked with approved pictograms, with chromatic contrast and nontactile located at a height of 185 cm .

The toilet door does not contrast with the wall. Homogeneous illumination without a timer. Non-slip flooring. There are no obstacles or unmarked overhanging elements.

## Terrace

The terrace of the cafeteria la Carolinas is free of unmarked obstacles and overhanging elements.

## Toilets <br> 

There is no vacant/engaged visual system.
There is no lower strip on the cabin door.

## Access

There is an accessible route to Carolinas-Fira station via a ramp with a $3.4 \%$ slope, more than 800 cm long and more than 400 cm wide. It has a handrail on each side at a height of 107 cm .

Access to Benimàmet Station from outside the park is by means of a ramp that is more than 10 m long, more than 200 cm wide and which has a $2.4 \%$ slope. It can be accessed from the park via a flat area and an accessible route.

Amphitheatre
An amphitheatre in the flat area, with homogeneous, non-slop paving. There are stone benches 160 cm apart.

At the front and sides of the benches, a circle with a diameter of more than 400 cm can be traced, giving a full view of the staged, where the PRM can be accommodated.

## Indoor mobility

The Parque Lineal comprises a 1200-metre linear promenade running west to east. It has a landscaped area of more than $30,000 \mathrm{~m}^{2}$, a cycle lane, a children's play area, a petanque court, a picnic area, an amphitheatre, a dog socialisation area and several petanque courts.

Throughout the parque lineal, there are slopes of up to $4.6 \%$ and more than 300 cm wide. There is asphalt paving most of the way around the park, and some areas with gravel. Furniture for resting is available throughout the park.

## Access

Access to the Carolinas-Fira station is via 4 steps with a height of 15 cm and a tread of 28 cm . There is a handrail on each side at a height of 75 cm . There is a ramp with a $3.4 \%$ slope; it is more than 800 cm long and more than 400 cm wide. It has a handrail on each side at a height of 107 cm .

Access to Benimàmet Station is via 3 steps that are 15 cm high and 30 cm wide with handrails on each side at a height of 97 cm . There is a ramp that is more than 10 m long, more than 200 cm wide and has a $2.4 \%$ slope. There is a handrail on each side at a height of 100 cm . There is non-slip and homogeneous paving.

The Parque Lineal comprises a 1200-metre linear promenade running west to east. It has a landscaped area of more than $30,000 \mathrm{~m}^{2}$, a cycle lane, a children's play area, a petanque court, a picnic area, an amphitheatre, a dog socialisation area and several petanque courts.

There is homogeneous asphalt paving most of the way around the park, and some areas with gravel. There are no obstacles or unmarked overhanging elements.
